1. Write a function called `isVowel()` that takes one character argument. The function returns true if the character is a vowel, and false otherwise.
 2. Write a function called `allVowels()` that takes three individual characters. The function returns true if all three characters are vowels, and false otherwise. It should use the helper function `isVowel()` for this. For example, a, u, e will return true.
 3. Write a function called `alternateVowels()` that takes three individual characters. The function returns true if the first and the third character are vowels, and the second character is a non-vowel. Otherwise it returns false. It should use the helper function `isVowel()` for this. For example, a, w, i will return true.
 4. Write a function called `twoVowels()` that takes three individual characters. The function returns true if any two of the characters are vowels and one is a non-vowel. Otherwise it returns false. It should use the helper function `isVowel()` for this. For example, a, w, i will return true, and a, i, w will also return true.
