- 3. Write a function called alternateVowels() that takes three individual characters. The function returns true if the first and the third character are vowels, and the second character is a non-vowel. Otherwise it returns false. It should use the helper function isVowel() for this. For example, a, w, i will return true.
- 4. Write a function called twoVowels() that takes three individual characters. The function returns true if any two of the characters are vowels and one is a non-vowel. Otherwise it returns false. It should use the helper function isVowel() for this. For example, a, w, i will return true, and a, i, w will also return true.
