

Palindrome

A Palindrome is a string of characters that reads the same forward and backward (ignoring spaces, if any). Here are some examples:

mom

racecar

noon

12344321

Was it a car or a cat I saw

Write a program to input a string. Then determine and print out a message saying whether the string is a palindrome or not. You'll need to work with strings. Refer to Chapter 10 for working with strings. There are two ways: 1) using C-string, and 2) using the string class.

This is how you can rate yourself:

- A – If you can do each of the questions in 10 minutes.
- B – If you can do each of the questions in 15 minutes.
- C – If you can do each of the questions in 25 minutes.
- D – If you cannot do all of the questions.
- F – If you cannot even do one question.
